Landed aboard the Queen Mary on the same voyage as Mackenzie King, former Prime Minister of Canada. According to my mother I shook hands with him while he was on a walk outside. According to Mackenzie's diaries Lester Pearson also former Prime Minister was also on voyage, he was Canada's ambassador to the U.N. At the time they went to Ottawa time by train and we went to Toronto by train.

We stayed temporarily at my uncle Bobs, after Jan. 1/47. I was only three years old but had dual citizenship because my father was born in Canada and I was born in greater London, England and my mother was a British war bride. My father was a volunteer in the Royal Canadian Engineers. My parents are deceased now and I was too young to remember other than just flashes.
