Pier 21 offers several immigration themed workshops all year round or to celebrate International Migrants' Day on December 18. Try our Landed Immigrant Workshop (undergo a 1928-1971 style immigration interview with a costumed staff member and keep your stamped passport as a souvenir) or our Coming to Canada Workshop (students will play games and interact with a number of artifacts that might have been brought to Canada by the immigrants of Pier 21's time). Older students will also enjoy our Refugee Workshop (learn about the refugee system in Canada today and through the past through case studies, presentations and empathy games).
