### Heritage Workshops

Celebrate Heritage Day with our **Genealogy Workshop (Gr. 4+)** – This workshop introduces students to primary research. Students will discuss what genealogy is and what can be learned through genealogy. Students will use primary documents to search for answers to clues provided about a sample family. This workshop gives students the basic skills they need to start their own research and discusses some of the difficulties genealogists encounter when searching for information.



### Citizenship Workshops

Pier 21 offers several citizenship themed workshops all year round. National Flag Day, February 15, 2008 is a great time to bring your group or class to try one out. Younger students will enjoy our **Inuksuk Workshop** – Students learn about Canada's newest territory, Nunavut. Students will learn about the use of the Inuksuk and how it is a symbol to remind us to help others find their way when they are new to Canada. The Inuksuk teaches us how to be good citizens. Students will make their own inuksuk door or wall hanging craft. Older students, Scouts, Guides and Cadets will love our **Citizenship Workshop** – Students gain an insight into what it means to be Canadian. They will discuss different multicultural models, recite an oath of citizenship and attempt a series of sample questions from the citizenship test. Citizens are often surprised by how poorly they do.
