VETERANS' WEEK!

Veterans' Week is November 5-11. There will be activities at Pier 21 all week long culminating in a family day on November 11th. Activities include writing post cards to veterans, poppy crafts, swing dancing, special WWII tours and more. Veterans and war brides are free November 11th. During November, we will also be showcasing our Lest We Forget Workshop and our World of Violence – Culture of Change: Swing Dance Workshop. Both workshops engage students with the culture surrounding the WWII period.

LAST CHANCE - Reflections: Canada-Hungary

Pier 21 welcomes a new traveling exhibit from the Stewart Hall Art Gallery. Reflections: Canada-Hungary is an exhibition of fourteen artists of Hungarian descent. This exhibit coincides with the 50th anniversary of the Hungarian Revolution. In 1956, Canada received 37000 Hungarian refugees. Today, the Hungarian community in Canada numbers over 260000. Reflections: Canada-Hungary will be at Pier 21 from October 12-November 28 2006. Don't miss it!

Lest We Forget (Grades 4-9):

This workshop engages students in WWII culture. The highlight of this half hour workshop is a role-playing exercise in which students must successfully try to use ration stamps to buy everything they need for a Canadian winter.

A World of Violence – A Culture of Change : Swing Dance (Grades 4+):

Students learn about WWII culture, swing/jive basic and try out some moves.
