In 1955 on Feb 19, my mother - Ellen Colmer Robson and five of her children, including me, arrived at Pier 21 on the Samaria. We had about \$186.00 to our name yet Canada accepted us. We lived at Pier 21 until my mother and three of my older siblings found jobs and we found a home. My mother died only two years and four months after we arrived but she accomplished her task which was to give her children a better life with more opportunities than we would have had in Northern England.

I was almost eleven years old when we arrived at Pier 21 but I will never forget it. We had a reunion lunch at Pier 21 in 2005 celebrating our 50 year anniversary. Thanks for everything.
