We left Liverpool February 24th, 1934, on the S.S. Adriatic. The first day out, my parents became seasick, consequently, my brother, Solly, and I had the run of the ship. The officers and crew treated us in an extraordinary manner.

On March 1st I came down with chicken pox, and upon arrival in Halifax, on March 3rd, the ship was quarantined.

My parents, brother and I were taken to what I believe is the present Scotian Hotel. We were placed in a corner suite, in isolation.

I wish to thank Canada for the opportunity it gave me and my family, even though we could not speak or understand the languages. Becoming Canadian Citizens we were able to attain all our endeavors in life.
