My mother, deceased, came to Canada from her native Finland via the S.S. Stockholm, out of Sweden, in October 1927. She was at the time a single young woman, 21 years of age, traveling alone. My mother landed with \$25.00 in her purse and journeyed to Hamilton, Ontario to join her brother John and his wife Mary. My mother married in Hamilton and took the surname Sharp. I obtained a copy of her immigration record on a visit to Pier 21 about five years ago. My mother died in 1995 but is not forgotten. I am the only surviving member of her immediate family.
