His destination at the time was listed as Mrs Loudi Pearl (approximate spelling) in Ely , Minn. He actually ended up going through Buffalo, NY and settled in Lorain, Ohio. He raised a family, worked for the Lake Terminal railroad and owned a Window Shade and Gift Shop.
