According to my father's notes, they arrived in Halifax on November 5, 1941 and left on November 10, 1941, after picking up 4875 English troops. This was the only time that I know of that this ship traveled in convoy. My father always said that it was faster than the others and so it sailed alone.

They left Singapore on January 15, 1942, and after several other trips arrived back in San Francisco USA on March 31, 1942. His correspondence during this time was through the ship and so was censored meaning no mention of where they were or what they were doing.

My father would send letters through the regular US mail when they were in the United States.
